Using your phone for audio/video recording

Most Smartphones (iPhone and Android) come equipped with several apps to allow users record and edit videost videos and audio. These recordings can be later inserted into a presentation or a document and/or uploaded directly to the Unit Project **Publicar** page.

How to shoot video with your iPhone or iPad

- Launch the Camera app on your iPhone or iPad.
- Tap **VIDEO** or swipe right to switch to video mode.
- Tap the red **RECORD** button to begin filming.
- Tap the red **STOP** button to end the video.
- Anything captured automatically gets saved to your device's Photo Library.
- You can also save it to any cloud service like iCloud, Google Drive or One Drive.
- Make sure you name the recording so that you know what project it will be uploaded to.

How to upload video to the Unit Project **PUBLICAR** from your Smartphone/IPAD

1. Open Google Chrome Browser App
2. Got to lingrolearning.com and login to your account.
3. Login and click the Unit Project **PUBLICAR**
4. Upload your file (video, doc or pdf). **Note:** for some smaller phones, you may need to turn the camera to landscape/horizontal position to upload.

How to shoot video with your Android Smartphone

- Launch the Camera app on your Android.
- Tap **VIDEO** or swipe right to switch to video mode.
- Tap the red **RECORD** button to begin filming.
- Tap the red **STOP** button to end the video.
- Anything captured automatically gets saved to your device's Gallery.
- You can also save it to any cloud service like iCloud, Google Drive or Microsoft One Drive.
