



As a student, it is likely you will mainly use the **Assignments** area of your **Dashboard** to access your assigned material from your instructor (like pages to read and activities to complete).

However, you have access to **ALL** course content anytime you wish. This is useful for navigating to certain areas, like when you want to go back and review notes for a quiz or test for example.

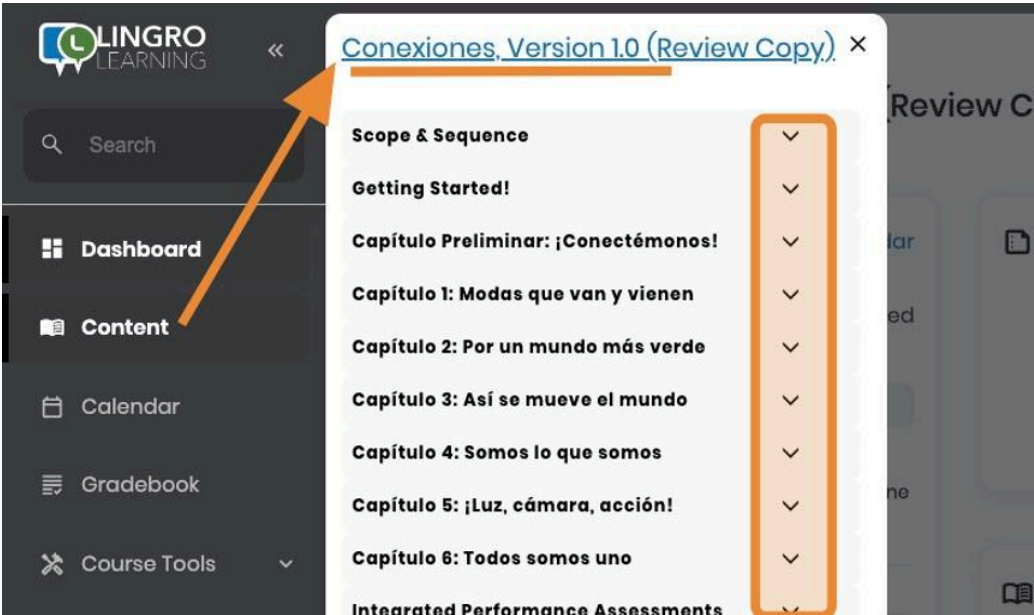
Below are instructions for how to **navigate your course content** similar to how you would a printed textbook.

1. Click on **Content** to see your course content, including all lessons and activities for each chapter/unit.

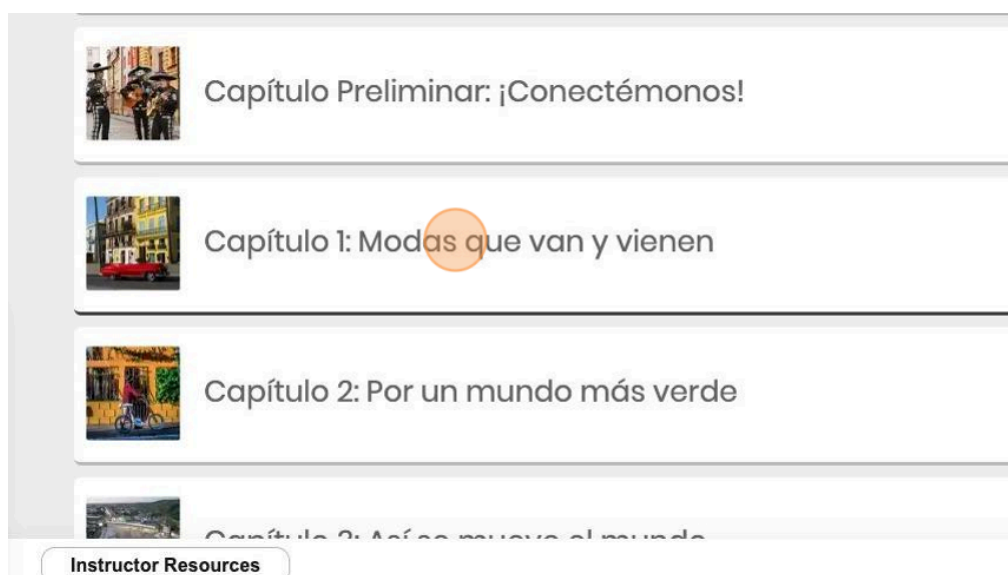
You can expand a chapter/unit to see all its contents by clicking on the **drop-down arrow** next to the chapter/unit.

OR

You can click on the **Course title** at the top of the window to see all course content in full screen mode.



2. In the **Content** full screen mode, you can scroll down to view all course content. Simply click on the chapter/unit you wish to view.



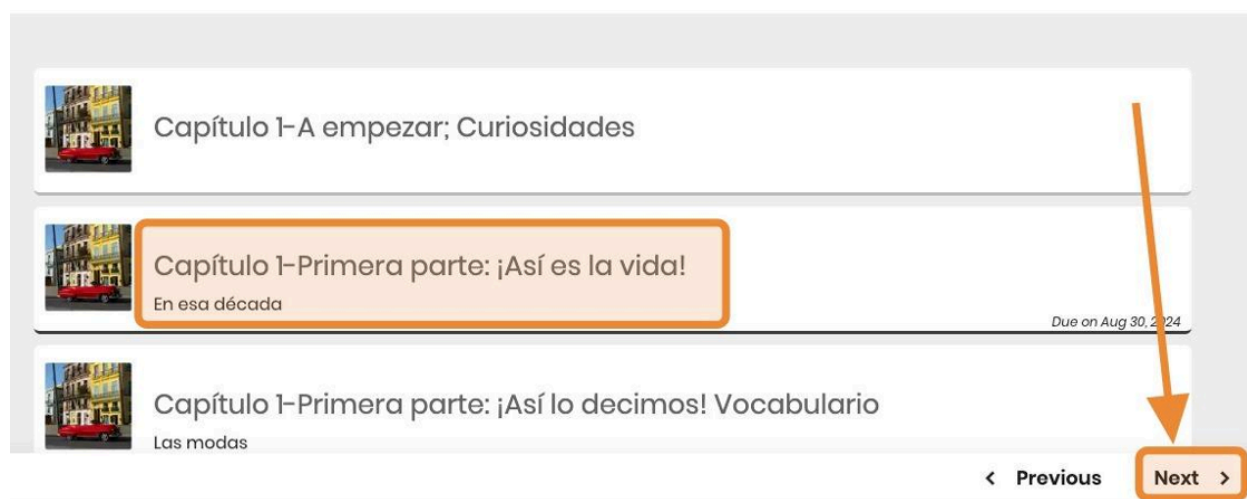
3. The chapter/unit start page appears.

From this page, you can use the **Next** and Previous buttons to navigate to the next or previous sections.

OR

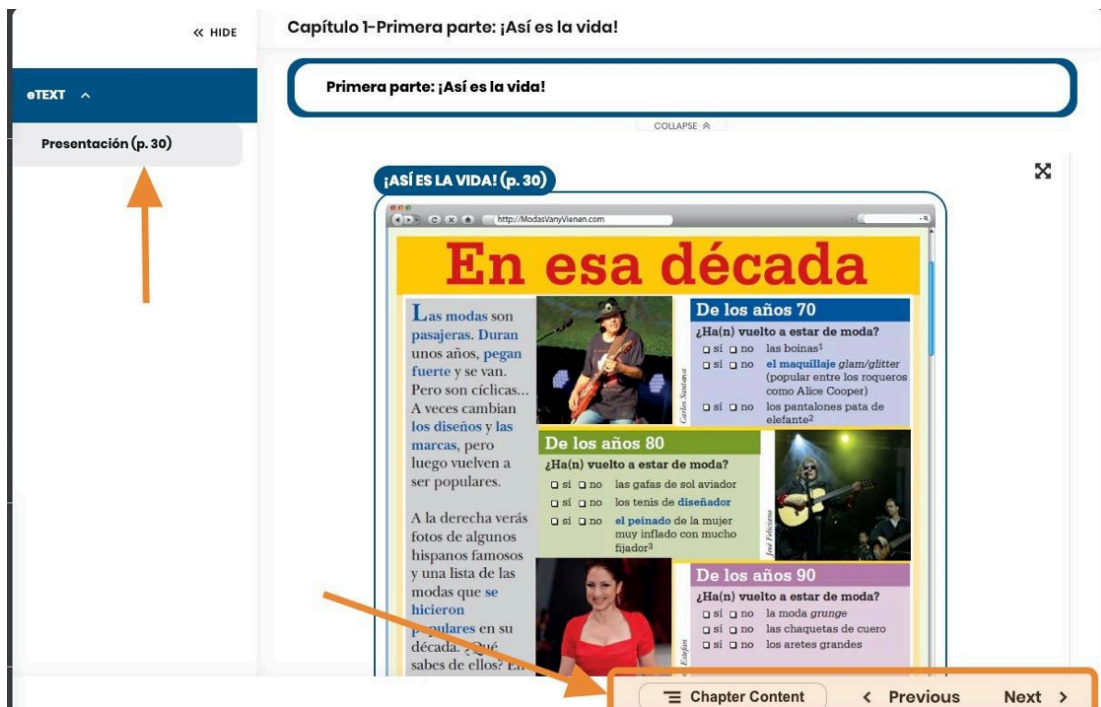
You can click on the particular chapter/unit section you wish to see\*.

\*In this example, the student wants to see material from **Primera parte: ¡Así es la vida!**, so they simply click on the section to access it.



5. The section page appears. In the **left menu** tabs, you can view the **eText** (pages from the textbook) and any activities that correspond with this section. (**NOTE:** In the example shown, there are no activities for this section and so none are visible.)

You can navigate to the **next section** in the chapter/unit by clicking **Next**, and to the previous section by clicking **Previous**.




6. You can also access **all** the chapter/unit sections by clicking on **Chapter Content**.




7. In the next section - ¡Así lo decimos! Vocabulario - you can see that there are more options in the **left menu tabs**.

**IMPORTANT:** Be sure to **expand all tabs** to see all content available for the section.



8. To attempt an activity, simply click on the activity listed in the left menu, then click **START**.

**IMPORTANT** - It is best practice to refer to your course Calendar for items that are assigned to you by your instructor. **Navigating the course content** is useful for reviewing material, taking notes, and completing practice activities.
